- 2. The application of Messrs. Carl Rohde & Co. for 50 shares No. 36 was accepted, and it was resolved that the fifty shares applied for be and are hereby allotted in pursuance of Messrs. C. Rohde & Co's application making, with the previous allotments, an aggregate number of 492 shares allotted.
- 3. Mr. Caldwell's telegram announcing registration of the company read & recorded.
- 4. Mr. Rohde presented certain estimates showing the probable cost of plant to be £5800

Land & buildings 25,000

\$67,000

In addition to which the expenses of fitter, house for brewer and working stock had to be considered. After discussion it was <u>Resolved</u> to await the return of certain detailed estimates expected by Messrs. Carl Rohde & Co, and thereon draw up fresh estimates of capital required and probable results for submission to a special meeting of shareholders before which the question of additional capital shall be brought.

Carried unanimously.

- 7. A letter from the China & Japan Trading Co. read & directed to be answered. The application was for the agency of the Co. at Nagasaki.
- 8. Mr. North's proposition declined.
- 9. Common seal for the Co. to be provided.
- 10. Division of board into committees deferred.
- 11. Messrs. Carl Rohde & Co's letter taken as read.
- 12. Cheque for \$3,600 in payment of land favour Mr. Edgar Abbott signed.
- 13, 14, 15, & 16 deferred.
- 17. Other business. Resolved that a short advertisement be inserted in a newspaper announcing fact of registration of company in Hongkong with limited liability.

The meeting then adjourned pending receipt of estimates. (4.50 p.m.)
