Present: Messrs Dodds (Chairman), Grosser, Baehr and Winstanley.

- 1. The minutes of director's meetings held on the $23^{\rm rd}$ & $26^{\rm th}$ August, 1886 were read, confirmed and signed.
- 2. The following letter from Mr. Diack was read.

157 Bluff 23rd Sept. 1886

To the Secretary

Japan Brewery Co. Limited

Dear Sir,

I think I now see my way tolerably clear to providing a building for the company's purposes, that is Brewery and Cellarage- having the same area and arrangement as the German plans (without the malting house) for a sum of \$25,000.- leaving the remaining \$5,000.- available for extras.

Trusting this will meet with the approval of the directors.

style of building or mentioning in what manner the saving in the former

estimate was to be effected. It was, therefore, resolved that, time being

precious, two of the directors, Messrs. Baehr and Winstanley, or Mr. Talbot,

should see Mr. Diack and get information from him on the points required.

Further, it was resolved that in the event of the interview with Mr. Diack

and his plans being considered satisfactory that steps be taken to submit

same to a third party for definite approval, and if so approved, that Messrs.

Carl Rohde & Co be authorized to transmit the order for plant &c. to

Germany. It was also resolved, that in anticipation of the order for plant

going forward at an early date, exchange should be settled for £ 2,000 and

that Mr. Baehr should take this matter in hand.

3. Letter from Mr. Shibusawa, dated 17th Sept 1886, read and secretary

instructed to write a reply informing Mr. Shibusawa that the calls have

been made in accordance with the requirements of the company, funds being

wanted for remittance to Europe for plant.

4. Cheque for \$47.64 for ground rent on Bluff lot No 105B was signed.

The meeting then adjourned.
