<u>Interest on Acceptances</u> This matter was discussed but it was deemed advisable not to take any action for the present.

> Severine's Pay increased

Mr.Severine's Pay It was decided to increase his salary \$5 per month counting from the first of the year. Mr. Blanc proposed that it would be much better if we had some fixed rule for increasing Salaries that would obviate the necessity of the company's servants having to apply for an increase, and he promised to draw up a Scheme for that purpose.

► Bottles ordered through Carl Rohde & Co.

Bottles It was decided to order 100000 bottles, 50,000 each of pints and quarts through Messrs. Carl Rohde & Co. at once.

➤ <u>5% Commission to Dealers</u>

<u>Comn to Dealers</u> It was decided that the Secretary could use his discretion in this matter to the extent of 5% Commission and this was considered ample.

Assistant Brewer
