<u>Malt & Hops from America</u> Mr. Heckert now joined the meeting and he did not recommend the use of American Malt- as it was deficient in strength, compared with the German Malt- but he thought that a few American Hops might be judiciously mixed with those from Germany.

<u>Water</u> Mr. Heckert thought that all cause for anxiety about water was now removed.
