on Tuesday 29th November 1892 at 3.15 P.M.

The minutes of the last meeting were read and confirmed.

➤ Growing Competition with Asahi & Yebisu

The growing competition of Yebisu and Asahi beers and the consequent falling off in the sales of “Kirin” and Mr. Isono’s proposals for meeting the same, was the only business before the Board, and every point was thoroughly discussed.

The Directors realizing that the questions involved were of such a serious nature that no decision could be arrived at today, and it was Resolved to adjourn the meeting until the Board could get from Isono the comparative statement of sales he was preparing for it and the meeting was therefore adjourned to an early day to be fixed by the Chairman.
