Directors Meeting held on Wednesday 22nd March 1893 at the Brewery at 3.45 p.m.

Present: Messrs. J. Dodds (Chairman), H. Baehr, T.B. Glover, D. Fraser,

W. Gordon, and Mr. M. Kirkwood by invitation.

The <u>Minutes</u> of the last meeting were read – an omission in connection with the remuneration of the new Secretary was pointed out, duly recorded, and the Minutes as amended, then confirmed.

Bottle Supply from Okawa of Tokyo

Bottle Supply Mr. Heckert's Report on the sample lot of Bottles received from Mr. H. Okawa of Tokyo was read, and the Chairman stated that thereon negotiations, had been opened with the manufacturer, which promised to lead to a satisfactory arrangement being made. A letter from the Brewery to Mr. H. Okawa of Tokyo proposing terms of Contract was read and confirmed, and it was further decided that in addition Mr. Isono should be authorized to buy up all available supplies of Yebisu Bottles on even terms with our own bottles.

Letter from Schwabe

<u>Auditorship</u> A letter from Mr. Schwabe was read expressing his willingness to continue the Audit of the Company's Book to 31st March 1893, and recorded with satisfaction.

Discount to Y. U. Club and German Club

<u>Discount</u> to <u>Y. U. Club</u> and <u>German Club</u>. – It was agreed that these clubs should have the benefit of full discount on monthly Accounts irrespective of amount.

Mr.Gibbs's Bonus

<u>Mr.Gibbs Bonus</u> It was agreed that this should be paid at the end of the financial year, 31st March 1893, the amount being proportionally increased to cover the longer period.

<u>Isono's Advertising Expense 1892</u> A letter from Mr. <u>Isono</u>, dated 14th March agreeing to the amount voted by the Board was read and recorded.

Removal of the Offices to the Brewery

<u>Removal of the Offices to the Brewery</u> This question was then discussed, and decided in the affirmative as being advantageous in the general interests of the Brewery, whereon it was agreed that Plans and Estimates for new.

Office and General Store Room

<u>Office</u> and <u>General Store Room</u> should be obtained from some European Architect, it being understood that total cost of additions should not exceed Two thousand Dollars (\$2,000).

Salary of Late Secretary W. Walker

<u>Salary of late Secretary Mr.W.Walker</u> It was resolved that this should be paid to 31st instant, at the rate of Two hundred and fifty Dollars (\$250) per month.
