The Minutes of the previous Meeting of $14^{\rm th}$ May were read and confirmed.

➤ New Debenture Issue

New Debenture Issue A remark was made that exception had been taken by one of the present large holders as to the term of the Debenture. If bought at 104 and paid off at the end of 3 years the Debenture would bear interest at less than 6% per annum,- actually $17 \div 3=5$ 2/3%. Mr. Gordon pointed out that holders who exchanged their old Debentures for new ones would be in precisely the same position after the change as they are now. A proposal was made that as no term had been stated in the advertisement a date 15 years after issue be decided upon but it was resolved after discussion not to make any alteration in this respect.

Debenture Registration and Transfer Fees

The present Fees being deemed so high as to be prohibitive. It was determined to make the Charge for registration of each Debenture of the new Issue 25 Cents and for a transfer of any number 50 Cents.

should be made in the selling price of cased beer to Mr. Isono.

Mr. Hutchison having however been called away the meeting closed at 4.20 p.m. before a final decision was come to but it was resolved that the Secretary should consult with Messrs Baehr and Hutchison informing them of the opinions expressed and finally with the Chairmans approval act accordingly.
