Minutes of Special Directors Meeting held at No.7 Water Street, at 12.20 p.m. on Thursday, 7th April, 1904

Present: Jas Dodds (Chairman), C.B. Bernard, W.R. Bennett

Special Meeting of Directors Relating to Dodd's Resignation from the Board

It was mentioned that a message from Mr. Glover & a letter from M. Haynemann had been received, expressing their great regret that they would be unavoidably absent from this Meeting.

The Minutes of Meeting of 18th March were read and confirmed.

The Financial Statement prepared for the Meeting was read.

Dodds' Resignation from the Board

The <u>Chairman</u> then said that the present Meeting was called to relieve him, on his <u>departure to England</u>, from his duties as a Director of the Company. Having been a Director since its inception, he was very sorry to leave the Company, but he felt sure that, for the present, it is in good hands.

As to the <u>Management</u> between his departure & Mr. James return from England, it was thought that instead of appointing a Managing Director it would be better to ask the Banks to honour cheques signed by any one of the following Directors, viz: Mr. Bernard, Mr. Bennett, or Mr. Haynemann. This was agreed to, and the Secretary instructed to write to the Banks to that effect.

Increase in Beer Tax

The War increase in Beer Tax (from $\S7.00$ to $\S7.50$ per Koku), which came into force on the 1st inst. was noted. The question as to whether Meidiya

should be asked to consent to an increase of prices on account of this

additional Beer Tax, increased cost of leases, &c, was decided in the negative -

for the present.

At the close of the Meeting, Mr. Bennett, addressing the Chairman, said

that all the Directors very much regretted that Mr. Dodds was going away.

They would try to do the best they could, after his departure, for the interests

of the Company, but they had not the experience that he had. The Board was

very sorry to lose him. Mr. Dodds, in replying, mentioned how much his

duties as Chairman had been lightened since Mr. James had taken over the

management.
